

MMHP SCHOLARSHIP FUND

BACKGROUND:

Monmouth Mobile Home Park (MMHP) is a welcoming community located off Route 1 in South Brunswick (SB), New Jersey. It is a place where families and residents are able to live and prosper together. The park has been Family owned and operated for over 50 years. Our family and the Park staff are fully immersed in community life and are active members in Township activities. MMHP offers various events throughout the year to encourage and support community connectedness. We believe in supporting our residents as well as the members of the larger SB community. We are always looking for new ways to give back. We believe that giving back is one of the most important principles in life. With the world mired in a pandemic, the importance of giving back has been magnified. So this year, we've decided to create The MMHP Scholarship Fund as a way to help local students cover some of the costs associated with a college education.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this scholarship program is to help and support residents who are graduating from High School to obtain a college education.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants must live in MMHP.

Applicants must be Seniors in High School.

Award winners must enroll as full-time students at an accredited College/University or Vocational school in the fall immediately after graduation.

CRITERIA:

Applicants will be selected based on the following:

Good Scholastic standing- 3.0 and higher

Community Outreach/Involvement

Financial need

Personal character

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

In order for an application to be deemed complete and considered by the Selection Committee, it must include the following:

1. A completed application form.
2. Copy of grades/transcripts.
3. Typed personal essay (max 2 pages). Describe your dreams and ambitions for the future and how this scholarship will help you reach your goals.
4. A letter of recommendation from your advisor, counselor, or teacher.

The Scholarship Selection Committee, comprised of the MMHP Board of Trustees will make the selection of each scholarship recipient and forward notice to SB Highschool. The winners of the scholarship will be announced at the award ceremony in June. The funds earned through this scholarship will be paid directly to the institution that the student enrolls in; checks made out to the institution may be sent directly to the student. The scholarship must be utilized within one year of the date of the award and may only be spent on expenses directly related to enrolling in school (tuition, room, board).

AWARDS:

Two \$2,500 scholarships
